JUVENILE JUSTICE EMERGENCY ORDERS IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 21-33
REGARDING EXTENDED TIME
PERIODS FOR HEARINGS DURING
STATE OF EMERGENCY

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic leading to federal, state, and local declarations of a State of Emergency, and pursuant to its authority under San Luis Obispo County Superior Court

Administrative Order No. 20-01 and the General Orders re: Implementation of Emergency

Relief Authorized Pursuant to Government Code Section 68115 by Chair of Judicial Council,

on March 18, 2021, and the Honorable Jacquelyn H. Duffy, dated March 19, 2021, the Court

hereby makes the following Order regarding hearings pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code

sections 631, 632, 637 and 657.

- 1. The purpose of this Order is to protect the health and safety of juvenile justice involved youth, their families, and the general public, by limiting the number of days that hearings are held on the juvenile justice calendar.
- 2. The Court finds that, for purposes of computing time under Welfare and Institutions Code sections 631, 632, 637 and 657, March 22, 2021 to April 16, 2021, inclusive, are deemed holidays because the emergency conditions prevent the Court from conducting proceedings or accepting filings as necessary to satisfy these deadlines on those dates.
- 3. THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE AS OF MARCH 22, 2021, AND THROUGH APRIL 16, 2021, AND MAY BE AMENDED AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE. IT IS SO ORDERED.
