

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE USE OF BAIL SCHEDULE**

The bail schedule contains a list of felony, misdemeanor and infraction violations.

The schedule is divided into several columns. The explanation for each column follows:

### **Source**

This column shows the California statute code abbreviation. The key for the abbreviations is found below.

### **Statute**

This column shows the code section number.

### **Degree**

F = Felony  
F1 = Felony 1<sup>st</sup> Degree  
F2 = Felony 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree  
M= Misdemeanor  
I = Infraction

### **Offense Description**

This is the English language description of the crime.

### **Mandatory Appearance**

This field shows whether the defendant is required to appear in court. “Y” (yes) means appearance is required. “N” (No) means that bail may be posted and forfeited in lieu of appearance.

**RULE:** If any one violation is a mandatory appearance, the whole case is a mandatory appearance.

**ONLY** if all violations are not mandatory appearance can bail be posted and forfeited in lieu of appearing.

### **Bail**

The amount of bail that is required before the defendant may be released from custody.
